Dot Award 2014 winners: prizes for Best Content, Best Design and Best use of ICT tools

Dot Award is a competition for students who make their own website and demonstrate that they know how to make practical use of the Internet.

The fourth edition of the Dot Award received entries from France, Lithuania, Portugal, El Salvador, and the Catalan-speaking areas. From the best sites an International Jury selected the winners and awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes for the Best Content, the Best Design and the Best use of ICT tools.

The first place for **Best Content** award is for http://fotofield.lt a web about photography made by a Lithuanian student, runner-up is http://damngames.cat and third place for http://social-bordeaux.fr.

<u>http://www.appdatedclass.edu.sv</u> by two students from El Salvador with very useful tips for instructors about teaching with technology gets the first place for **Best design** award. Second place is for http://maonabola.pt and third place for http://electrobot.pt.

And the website by three Portuguese students http://rf-herzt.pt, about physics and communications, gets the first place for **Best use of ICT tools** award. Second place is for http://www.zaisktenisa.lt and third place for http://www.sunite.cat.

The prize-giving will be organized by the schools of the winning participants.

This fourth year of the Dot Award was the result of cooperation between AFNIC (the Registry for the .fr domain from France), Kaunas University of Technology (.lt domain from Lithuania), DNS.PT Association (from Portugal), Asociación SVNet .SV and CONEXION from El Salvador and Fundació puntCAT (the Registry for the Catalan domain name), with the support of CENTR and LACTLD, the regional ccTLD organizations for Europe and for the Latin American and Caribbean region

Afnic (French acronym for "Association Française pour le Nommage Internet en Coopération") is the manager of the registry of domain names in the following geographical areas: .fr (France), .re (Reunion Island), .pm (St. Pierre and Miquelon), .tf (French Southern Territories), .wf (Wallis and Futuna), and .yt (Mayotte).

In an Order published in the Official Journal of the French Republic on 28th June 2012, Ms Fleur Pellerin, Junior Minister for the Digital Economy, appointed Afnic as the registry for the .fr TLD for a new five-year term.

Since its inception in 1998, Afnic's objective has been to help the development of an Internet that is secure and stable, open to innovation, and in which the French Internet community plays a key role.

To do so, its assignments are to excel in providing resilient essential services in the Internet's core infrastructure in France, develop and share its expertise in order to facilitate transition to the Future Internet.

Association DNS.PT is the ccTLD .pt registry. The DNS.PT Association, was formally established on May 9, 2013, as a private non-profit association, funded by FCT, IP - Foundation for Science and Technology, IP (FCT), where FCCN (.pt registry for the past 25 years) was merged, Association of Electronic Commerce and Interactive Advertising (ACEPI), Portuguese Association for Consumer Protection (DECO) and the representative designated by IANA - Internet Assigned Numbers Authority as responsible for the ccTLD.pt delegation.

The purpose of the DNS.PT is to manage, operate and maintain the top-level domain registration corresponding to Portugal, .pt, thereby complying with the law, the principles of transparency and publicity, their bylaws and the best applicable national and international technical, administrative and strategic recommendations.
