* Domain names can be registered and renewed for a period of 1 to 10 years. Creations and renewals for more than one year are billed and payable at once, multiplied by the number of years required for registration.

** Invoiced at the end of the month following the anniversary month.

Specific conditions:

- 1) The annual fee is payable in a single instalment. Whatever the date of accreditation of the new Customer, the annual fee is payable in full for the year.
- 2) In application of article 28 "Transfer of the contract", Afnic will apply special financial conditions to registrars taking over all or part of another registrar's domain name portfolio: pricing based on a quotation, depending on the units of work.
- 3) In application of Article 24 "Sanctions" of the 2024 Registration Contract and Article 4.1.2 of the Best Practices Guidebook for Abuse Management, Afnic will charge a flat fee of €100 (excl. VAT) for each justification operation launched during the remediation phase that results in deletions.
- 4) The costs incurred by Afnic as a result of bank rejections shall give rise to the payment of a penalty of €10 (excl. VAT) per direct debit rejection, starting with the 2nd rejection, regardless of the application of Article 10 of the contract relating to penalties applicable in the event of late payment of amounts owed by the Registrar.
- 5) In the case of grace periods related to creation operations, the amount of the monthly credit per registrar shall not exceed the amount corresponding to:
 - the creation of 50 domain names, or
 - 10% of the number of net creation for the month.
 - Afnic will retain the higher of the two values as the amount of the credit.
